Parishioner Guide to Your Workshop

Hello! Fr. Fest is excited to invite you to participate in St. Joseph's upcoming "Embracing the Future" initiative. These parish workshops are organized around interactive and collaborative exercises that will encourage parishioners to work together to prioritize what you think are the most important features to bring St. Joseph parish's mission to life. They are also designed to encourage collaboration and understanding among participants. These exercises were designed to be fun and to help you grow closer to your fellow parishioners! Enjoy!

To help you get started, please see your guide below.

1. **Sign up for a workshop**: You can sign up at this <u>link</u> or by checking for a sign-up link on the St. Joseph website. We will have three workshop slots available at a time. Once a workshop is full, we will open another one! Each workshop will be scheduled for (at most) an hour and a half. For safety's sake, all workshops will be held via Zoom.

The first three sessions will take place on the following dates:

- Saturday, February 20, 2021 at 11am
- Tuesday, February 23, 2021 at 7pm
- Thursday, February 25, 2021 at 7pm

Please note that if you sign up for a workshop, it is very important that you attend.

- 2. **Read the exercise descriptions**: To help you get a sense of these interactive exercises, please read the "Workshop Exercises Description" document posted on the sign-up portal or listed on the parish website. This document will give you more detailed understanding of the workshop exercises along with a list and description of the features you will be discussing. Take time to read this document before attending a small group workshop. It will help you to make the most of your time with your fellow parishioners.
- 3. **Read the information packet**: The "Embracing the Future" Committee created an information packet to prepare parishioners for these workshops. This information packet is posted on the sign-up portal and listed on the St. Joseph website. The information packet includes information on the Church's mission, the mission of a Catholic parish, St. Joseph's territory and demographics, larger trends within the Church and society, information on the St. Joseph parish site and facilities, a summary of recent parish financials, as well as a catalogue of the parish's various prophetic, priestly, and shepherding efforts. It will be helpful to take time to review this material before attending a small group.



4. **Attend**: The last step is to attend your scheduled workshop! Be prepared for fun and engaging conversations with your fellow parishioners.
