



As We Prepare to ReGather at Resurrection
9:30 am Sunday

The Gathering

- Mass will be celebrated in the small parking lot to the right of the building. Parking will be in the large lot to the left of the building.
- Reservations are required and people are encouraged to arrive early. Check-in begins at 9:00 am.
- Ushers will guide people from parking to the worship area for check-in. Hand sanitizing stations, as well receptacles for food and monetary donations, will be available as you arrive.
- Trained ushers will seat parishioners. Children need to remain with their parent/guardian at all times.
- Building is closed. Restrooms are **not** available.
- Everyone needs to wear a mask correctly from the time they leave their vehicle until the time they return to the parking lot.

The Celebration

- Liturgy will be celebrated with a few exceptions:
 - We will not sing during the celebration.
 - One lector will read the readings and the responsorial psalm.
 - No collection will be taken up during the Mass.
 - Please do not hold hands during the Lord's Prayer.
 - There will be no Sign of Peace.
 - Communion will be distributed at the end of Mass as people leave.

The Celebration

- Communion and Dismissal
 - All will receive the final blessing.
 - After the final blessing and dismissal:
 - Everyone will remain in their seats (no early leaving).
 - Dismissal will begin at the back of the worship area and will be directed by the ushers.
 - Those who choose not to receive communion will leave directly to the parking lot as directed by ushers.
 - Ushers will direct those who wish to receive communion to the two communion stations near the back of the worship area. A stand to hold your chair will be near the communion station.

The Celebration

- Reception of Communion
 - Those who wish to receive communion should sanitize their hands prior to receiving. You may bring your own sanitizer. There will also be sanitizer available.
 - The communicant will stand 6 feet from the person distributing communion. The minister will say, “The Body of Christ” and the communicant respond “Amen.” Then the communicant will move forward to receive.
 - The host will be placed in the hand without touching. If hands should touch the person distributing communion must re-sanitize their hands.
 - The person receiving will then step to a marked spot to the side, lift their mask and consume the Body of Christ, immediately re-mask and then move to their car.
 - Persons wishing to receive on the tongue will need to wait until the end. The person distributing communion on the tongue must sanitize hands after each communicant receives.
 - There will be no distribution of the Blood of Christ.

The Celebration

- Leaving
 - Parishioners need to proceed directly to their cars and avoid gathering outside the church. This ensures that all parishioners have a clear path to their cars while maintaining social distancing.
