



VISITATION GUIDELINES

- All visits must be scheduled in advance.
- Visitors must wear masks at all times by visitors and residents during indoor and/or outdoor visits. Masks are available if needed.
- All visitors must complete the COVID-19 questionnaire and be temperature screened upon arrival. Visitors will be denied entrance if they report or are observed with signs/symptoms of COVID-19 infection, have had recent exposure to a COVID-19 positive person, or have a temperature of 100.0 degrees or greater.
- No more than two visitors per resident are allowed per scheduled visit.
- Visitors must remain in designated areas and maintain social distancing. Visitors should maintain at least 6 feet of distance from all other visitors, residents, and staff for the entire duration of the visit.
- Visits are limited to 60 minutes.
- Please perform hand hygiene before your visit using the alcohol-based hand sanitizer located at the entrance and throughout the facility.
- Physical contact with the resident you are visiting is strongly discouraged.
- Do not bring any food or drink for consumption during your visit.
- Minors are welcome if they are accompanied by an adult and follow visitation protocol.
- Before you leave the visitation area, please perform hand hygiene using the alcohol-based hand sanitizer located throughout the facility.

Visitation is contingent on compliance with these guidelines.
