

- Arrive at least 15 minutes early to fix your hair, clothing, and make-up. If your family needs more time, please plan ahead.
- Bring a hair brush and hairspray. It is very difficult to edit hair during post production so neat hair will make for nicer photos.
- If possible, wear contacts for the photos. If glasses are a must, please plan for a bit longer posing time to address glare issues.
- Have you picked an outfit? Try to limit prints and patterns. These can be distracting. A coordinated pallete of solid neutral colors is preferred. A coordinated color pallete between family members would also look nice. Minimize accessories or any other item that could pull attention away from your faces.
- We suggest makeup in natural shades with extra coats of mascara to emphasize lashes. Please bring makeup with you for touch ups. Lip balm or lipstick would be useful for dry lips.
- If a clean shaven look is desired, we suggest that you shave before the session and moisturize to minimze dry skin. Be caseful not to get cut! If facial hair is your preference, please make sure that it is styled as you intend. Just like head hair, facial hair is very difficult to edit afterward.
- Are we taking full length photos? Be sure that shoes are tidy and clean and socks match the look.
- Depending on the park, some photo locations can be over 100 yards from the check-in location and may require walking on grass or a dusty path. Please choose your footwear wisely. Changing footwear just before the photos may be a wise choice.
- Be careful not to wrinkle your clothes in the car or on the walk over! Hanging clothes on a hanger and carrying them until the final moment is good.
