If it rains on Friday, there will be no drop off time. If it rains on Saturday, there will be NO Swap.</p>	<p>BROWSING CLOSED UNTIL SATURDAY 12 NOON</p> <p><i>NOTE: Residents will NOT be allowed to browse when they drop their items off. All items **MUST BE IN GOOD, USABLE CONDITION** – no chips, cracks, tears, missing pieces, etc (we are not recycling pieces that should go to the Drop Off).

- No “stockpiling” of goods. Everything will be on display at noon when the browsing opens.
- Items operating with batteries or electricity **MUST** be in good working order.
- Dishes, glassware and flatware need to be in sets of no less than 2
- All items **MUST** be brought to the Swap in **carry size boxes labeled with contents and likewise items must be boxed together** (i.e. dishes packed with dishes, glasses packed with glasses, toys packed with toys, etc). Do not mix contents.

Anything brought to the Swap not packed and labeled as directed, will be turned away

<u>Acceptable Items</u>	<u>Unacceptable Items</u>
<p>Dishes (place settings for 2, serving pieces) – No chips or cracks</p> <p>Glasses (no single glasses)</p> <p>Flatware & Kitchen Utensils (boxed & labeled – sharp knives should be separate)</p> <p>Small Household appliances – must be in good condition & working order</p> <p>Small Household items – If one person can’t easily carry it don’t bring it <i>-must be able to carry in/carry out</i></p> <p>Artwork (framed and unframed)</p> <p>Mirrors – no chips or cracks</p> <p>Toys –make sure all pieces are present if applicable and boxed. If no box, put into a Ziploc baggie</p> <p>Games & Puzzles – make sure all pieces are present and boxed. Put into a Ziploc baggie if you do not have the box</p> <p>Sports Equipment – No more than 10 years old and must be in good condition (acceptable items – baseball & softball gloves, bats, golf clubs, basketballs, soccer balls, ice skates, tennis racquets, cleats and downhill and cross country skis with poles) We will not accept Hockey or Lacrosse sticks.</p> <p>Camping Equipment – can’t be more than 5 years old and no sleeping bags</p> <p>Garden Tools & Work Tools</p> <p>Electronics – working computers & working laser printers (UNDER 10 YRS OLD), space heaters, vacuum cleaners, stereo speakers and digital flat screen televisions</p>	<p>(Can be taken to the Drop off)</p> <p>Knick-Knacks</p> <p>Car seats more than 3 years old</p> <p>Office Furniture</p> <p>Large Furniture</p> <p>DVD’s; CD’s; Records</p> <p>Old Electronics (older than 10 years old)</p> <p>Televisions</p> <p>Books</p> <p>Carpets & Rugs</p> <p>Pillows</p> <p>Clothing & shoes</p> <p>Holiday lights & Decorations</p> <p>Large Exercise Equipment</p> <p>Bicycles</p> <p>Large Appliances</p> <p>Hockey & Lacrosse Sticks</p> <p>Sleeping Bags</p> <p>Cords/Cables</p>
