

INSTRUCTIONS FOR WRITING POSTCARDS TO WISCONSIN & MICHIGAN
(IF YOU GIVE CARDS TO FRIENDS, PLEASE GIVE THEM THE INSTRUCTIONS)

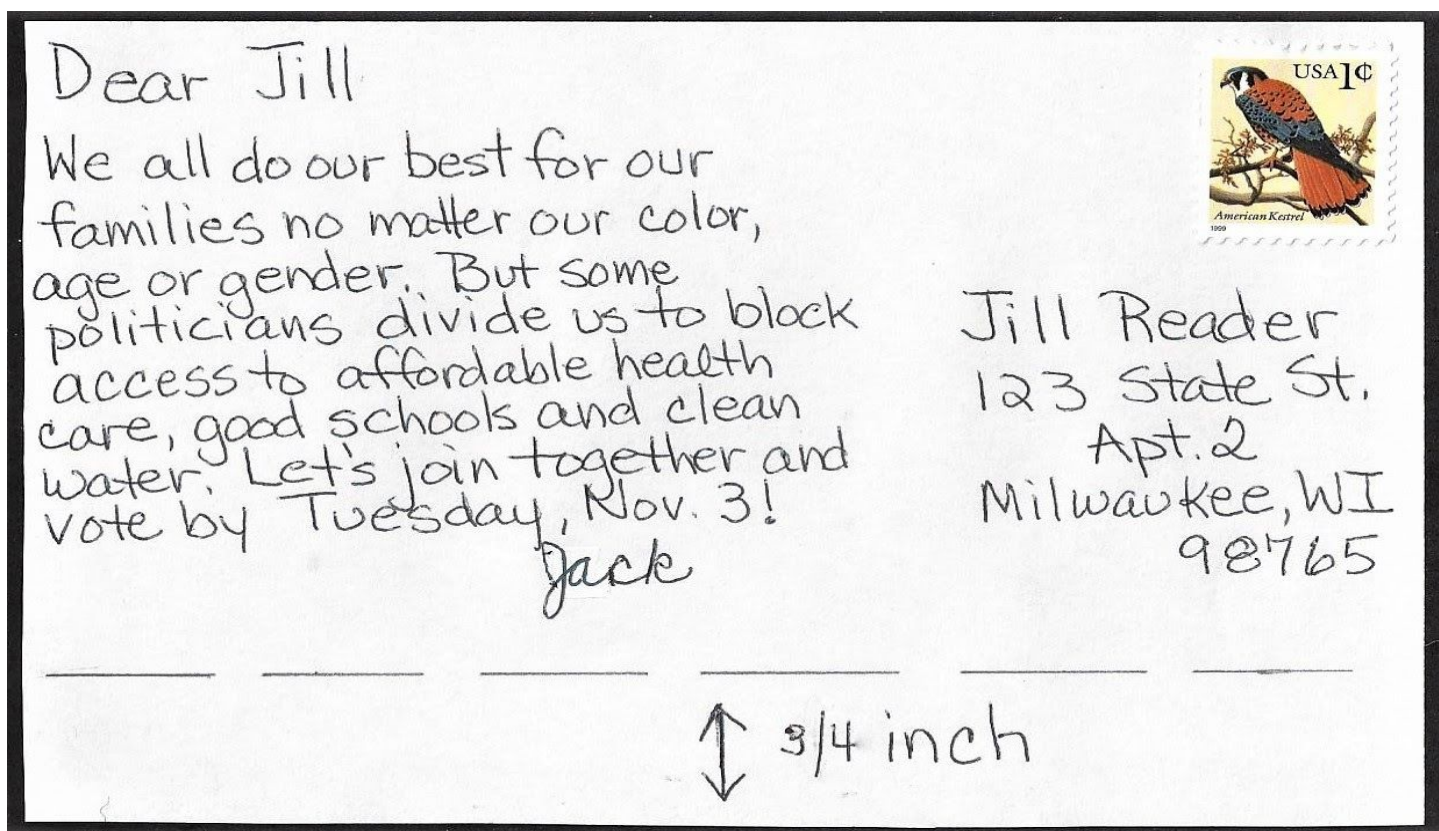
1. **SEE SCRIPT ON OPPOSITE SIDE.** Please follow the script content exactly. This is also a research project, so all cards sent to voters must say the same thing.
2. Sign the message with only your first name. Do **not** include your full name or return address.
3. Put a line through each address you complete.
4. Proofread all cards to check for stamp, completeness, and that first name on message and address are the same.
5. **All cards will be mailed at the end of October.** Due to issues surrounding the deadline for obtaining absentee ballots, we cannot yet identify the mailing date. **We will notify you of the required mailing date closer to the election.** You can either:
 - a. Hold onto the completed cards and mail them yourself on the specified October mailing date; or
 - b. Bring the completed cards back to where you picked them up. We will mail them in Wisconsin/Michigan on the specified October mailing date. **Please do not return cards without postage.**
6. **Tips for writing postcards:**
 - a. Don't write too closely to the bottom of the card. The post office puts a sticker along the bottom with address info. (See Sample).
 - b. If you are right handed, write the message first, to avoid smudging the address. If you are left handed, write the address first, to avoid smudging the message. Use a non-smudging pen.
 - c. Leave room at the top right corner for the stamp.
 - d. You can use white-out to correct small errors, but don't white out a large swath of writing. Use a new postcard if the error is major.
