BEFORE ATTENDING SERVICES

- **YOU SHOULD NOT ATTEND CHURCH**

If you have any signs or symptoms of COVID 19 as outlined in the CDC guidelines or have come in contact with anyone showing such symptoms, or if you have come into contact with COVID 19 positive persons within the last 2 weeks.

CHURCH ATTENDANCE

ARRIVE ON TIME

To ensure we adhere to all the requirement and guidelines we appreciate you arriving to Church on time.

MASKS

Individuals who are fully vaccinated are not required to wear masks in any setting. Individuals who are not fully vaccinated are encouraged to continue wearing a facemask over the nose and mouth and observe social distancing.

MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE

Please remember to stay a safe distance from others (3 feet minimum). Refrain from shaking hands or kissing others during the service.

OFFERINGS

Collection baskets will not to be passed. At the end of Liturgy, a basket will be placed in the back and parishioners will be encouraged to leave their donation as they exit. Or you may continue with your online donations.
