

Rainbow Days Volunteer Guidelines & Safety Protocols Summer 2021

Thank you for your service to Rainbow Days. Your safety and the safety of those we serve is our highest priority. To that end, Rainbow Days will be adhering to the following Volunteer Safety Guidelines for Rainbow Days Summer 2021 Camps, Volunteer Activities & Events.

Volunteer, Staff & Participant Exclusions -

- <u>Fever</u> If you have been around anyone who has had a fever of 100.4 or greater, we ask that you please stay home.
- <u>COVID-19 Exposure</u> If you or anyone in your household has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or had direct exposure to the virus, we ask that you please stay home.

<u>Safety Precautions</u> – We will be using the following safety protocols for all volunteer opportunities at Rainbow Days from June 1 – August 31, 2021.

- <u>Temperature Checks</u> Rainbow Days Staff will conduct temperature checks with a non-contact temporal scan thermometer during volunteer activities involving children (i.e. at Summer Camp and at the Back-to-School event). This will occur when you check in at the beginning of your assigned volunteer activity.
- <u>Masks</u> Masks are <u>optional for Adults who are vaccinated</u>. <u>Masks will be required for those are not vaccinated</u>. Vaccination cards will not be required. You are welcome to wear your own mask or we will have disposable masks available.
- <u>Hand Sanitizing</u> Please wash your hands or use hand sanitizing gel when you first arrive. We will have hand sanitizer readily available in multiple locations for you to use.
- Gloves When serving food at camp/events and/or when sorting and delivering food in our food program, we ask that you please wear latex or plastic gloves that our staff will provide to you.
- <u>Physical Distancing</u> When indoors, please be mindful and respectful of other volunteers, staff and participant's personal space, by keeping a 3-6 foot distance from others.
- <u>Small Groups</u> The majority of volunteer opportunities will be conducted in small groups (i.e. 10 or less volunteers at a time).
- <u>Regular Cleaning</u> When volunteering at Rainbow Days offices, at camps or special events, we will be disinfecting and cleaning surfaces frequently.
