

Rainbow Days COVID-19 Volunteer Guidelines

Summer 2020

Thank you for your service to Rainbow Days. Your safety and the safety of those we serve is our highest priority. To that end, Rainbow Days will be adhering to the following Volunteer Guidelines, including restrictions and precautions, needed to ensure everyone's health and safety. These guidelines follow CDC recommendations. These same guidelines are in place for our employees, our partners and our offices.

Volunteer & Staff Exclusions –

- <u>Fever</u> If you have been around anyone who has had a fever of 100.4 or greater, we ask that you please stay home.
- <u>COVID-19 Exposure</u> If you or anyone in your household has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or had direct exposure to the virus, we ask that you wait one month after the diagnosis before volunteering.
- Risk Factors If you are over 70 years of age, have an auto-immune or health concern that makes you more vulnerable, then we ask that you not volunteer during these critical months.

<u>Precautions</u> – We will be using the following safety protocol for all volunteer opportunities.

- Antibacterial

 We ask that you wash your hands and use antibacterial hand frequently
 when volunteering with us. We will have hand sanitizer available in multiple locations in
 our office, with our staff and at our various volunteer locations in the community
 available for you to use.
- <u>Limited Contact</u> All volunteer opportunities will be conducted individually or in small groups of 10 people or less. No physical contact with other people will be required in your volunteer duties.
- <u>Social Distancing</u> We ask that all volunteers stay at safe distances from others, at least 6 feet apart.
- <u>Masks</u> We have facial masks for all staff and volunteers to use during volunteer opportunities to provide an extra safety precaution. If you have your own mask that you would like to bring, you are welcome to bring your own.
- Gloves When sorting and delivering food in our food program, we ask that you please wear latex or plastic gloves that our staff will provide to you.
- Office When volunteering at our office, masks are required in our common areas. You can also be assured that all surfaces are being regularly disinfected.
