PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Please refrain from bringing valuables and large purses/book bags. Street Life Ministries is not responsible for any lost items.

DRESS CODE

Modesty is required. Again, this is for your safety as well as the people being served.

Tops- All tops must have sleeves and be full length. No sleeveless shirts, tank, halter, crop, tight or low cut tops.

Pants- Full length or shorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. No tight pants or short shorts.

Shoes- Closed toe shoes, no open-toed shoes, sandals or flip-flops.

SEXUAL HARASSMENT
